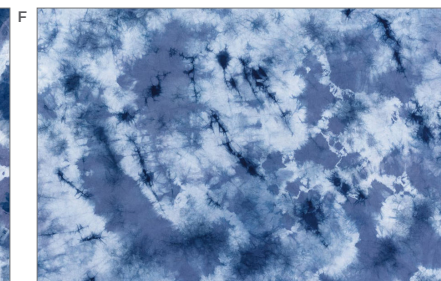
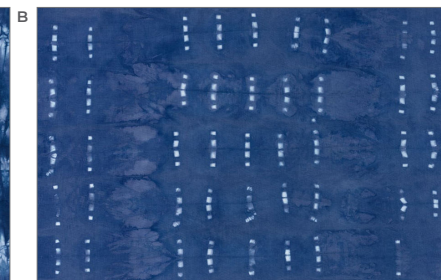
Shibori

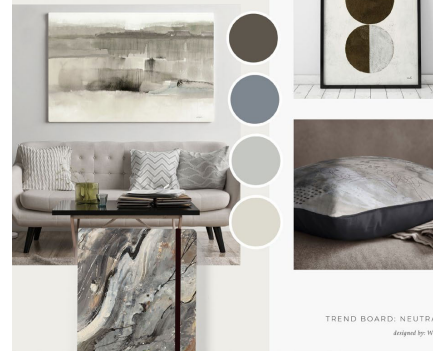

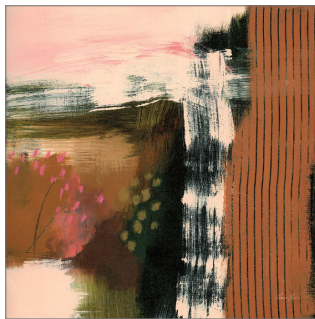
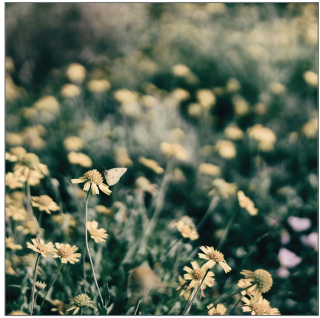
